



Corrigendum to **“FORMS: Forest Multiple Source height, wood volume, and biomass maps in France at 10 to 30 m resolution based on Sentinel-1, Sentinel-2, and Global Ecosystem Dynamics Investigation (GEDI) data with a deep learning approach” published in Earth Syst. Sci. Data, 15, 4927–4945, 2023**

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We have spotted a mistake in Sect. 3.1. The tiles used are 100 km², not 10 000 km² and it should read: “France was divided into 100 km² areas.”

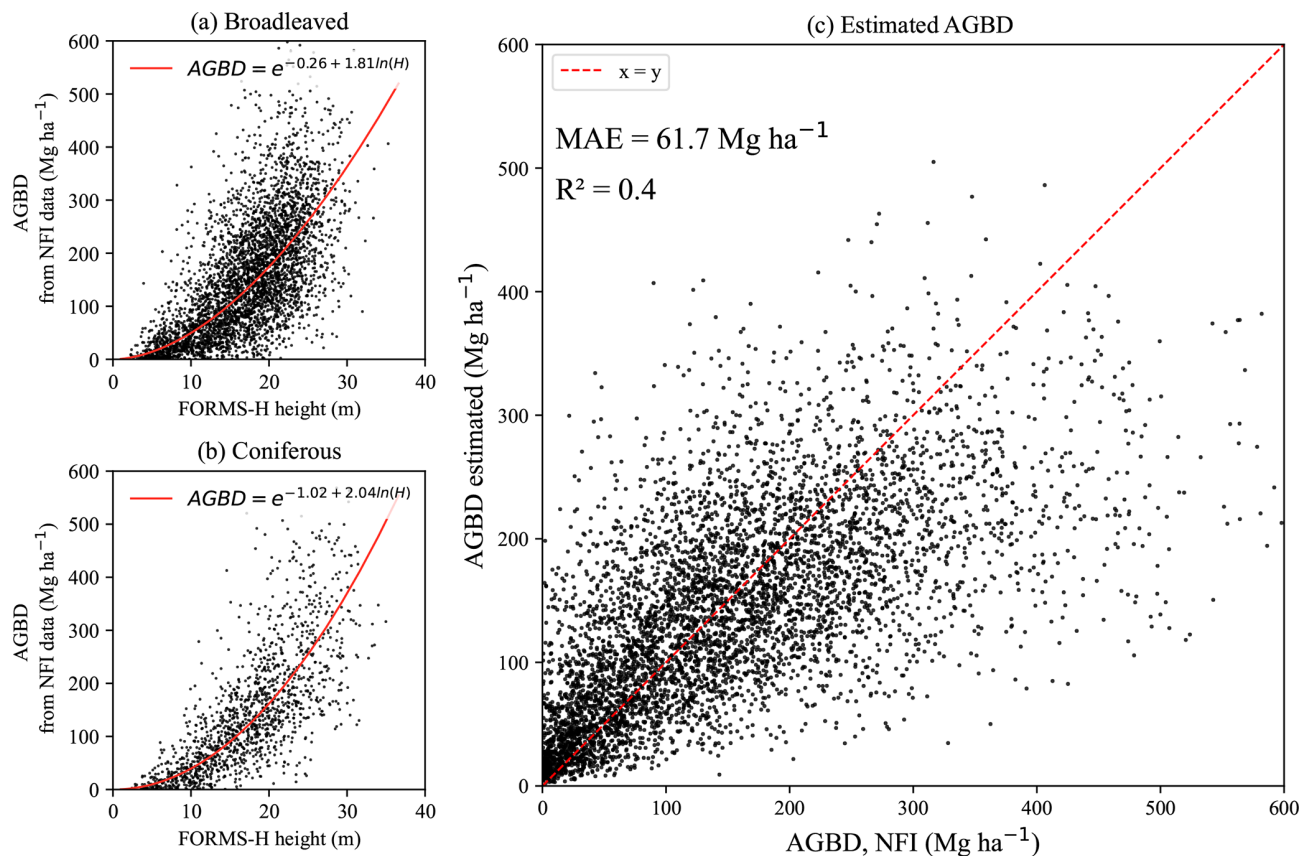


Figure 2. (a, b) Comparison of the AGBD from NFI plot data to FORMS-H for broadleaved and coniferous forests. The red line corresponds to the power-law allometric equation that we fitted to the data and used to transform our tree height map into an AGBD map. (c) Comparison of the AGBD estimated from the allometric equations and the actual AGBD of the NFI plots. The red dashed line corresponds to the 1 : 1 line.

Furthermore in Fig. 2a and b, the H in the equations should be replaced by $\ln(H)$.
