This paper is a contribution to the special issue in ESSD that in detail describes the data collection project known as CARINA. The study gives a clear and concise overview of the data from the Pacific sector of the Southern Ocean.

This is a valuable contribution to the area of chemical oceanography, and the data will be of great value for anyone conducting research in the Southern Ocean. The paper is well written and to the point, and certainly deserves publication in ESSD.

I have only a few minor comments that should be addressed before the paper can be published: Section 5: I believe that these calculations that are presented here really give a number of the internal consistency of the data, rather than the accuracy (although
