Regarding your comments:

1. About Introduction: I've re-written this a bit, but the structure is intended to be coherent with the other manuscript, and so, this is the reason for including first a general overview of carina, and then the introduction about of alkalinity.
2. Data Provenance and structure:

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- Comment about the first paragraph have been taken into account, and so, moved to data quality evaluation.
 - A map have been included, showing all stations with alkalinity data available.
 - Numbers have been corrected.
3. Data quality evaluation:
 - Added more explanation about why a MLR was performed here and their limitations.
 4. Figures:
 - All taken into account, except for the small maps indicating the location of the cruises. The location has been now explained in the description of the cruise.

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
