

***Interactive comment on “A new 100-m Digital Elevation Model of the Antarctic Peninsula derived from ASTER Global DEM: methods and accuracy assessment” by A. J. Cook et al.***

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In the abstract you state that: "The DEM is available for download from the NSIDC website: <http://nsidc.org/data/dems/datasets.html> (doi:10.5060/D47P8W9D)"

At the time of submission of the article, the dataset was not yet there, so you couldn't be more specific about the URL. Please improve it now with "<http://nsidc.org/data/nsidc-0516.html>"

Also, the DOI which you (had be) minted from the CDL EZID service just points to itself, not to the URL above, as it should be. Please correct this at least by inserting the URL into the "Location(URL)" field of EZID. (The DOI(\*) would obviously appear more  
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reliable if it would be provided by NSIDC directly.)
