

Interactive comment on “Seabed images from Southern Ocean shelf regions off the northern Antarctic Peninsula and in the southeastern Weddell Sea” by Dieter Piepenburg et al.

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General Comments This manuscript is a clear description of the methods and sampling regime of two Antarctic expeditions photographing the seabed using the Ocean Floor Observation System of the Alfred Wegener Institute. I found it very informative and easy to read. The standard of written English was very high (see some very minor comments below). The figures and images are clear and a useful illustration of the methods used. To the best of my knowledge the data are new, well presented and used in the correct way.

Specific issues I have no issues with this manuscript.

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Technical corrections P3L19 – replace “data of the OFOS” with “data for the OFOS” “OFOS” or “the OFOS”? Please be consistent P4L1 – replace “taken from interesting” with “taken of interesting” P4L2 – replace “which was recorded” with “which were recorded” P5L8/9 – reword “since in December 2015 it was located under fast ice and” to “it has been located under fast ice since December and” or similar.

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
