Thank you for your short comment. For now OCTOPUS only includes Be-10 and Al-26 data in modern fluvial sediment, and this is the reason why your CRN data from the Keep River region are not included.

Over the last couple of days, I uploaded some files to CRN InPrep to show samples that we have processed at UOW and where Be-10 and Al-26 data exist, but are not yet published. Coverage for the Australian continent is better than it seems by only looking at CRN Australia...

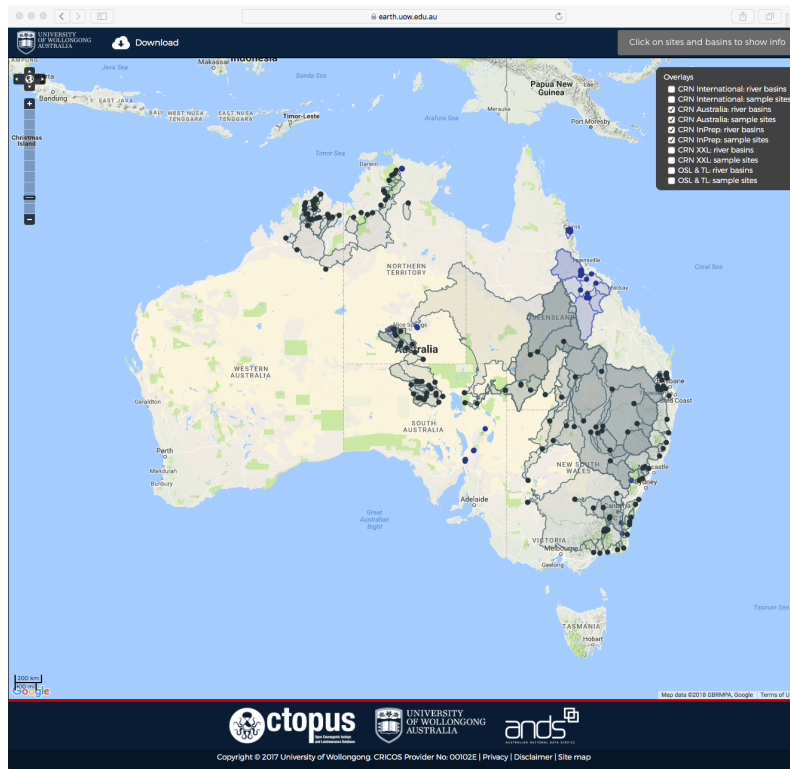
