

Interactive comment on “Last interglacial (MIS 5e) sea-level proxies in southeastern South America” by Evan J. Gowan

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I find this manuscript to be very well written and presenting an important, and long overdue, review of southeastern South America sea-level changes. The authors made a thorough work in putting together an important data set, and constantly point out the falls or pros of each of the data. All the figures and tables are well presented and are very clear, (although figure 5 should have a graphical scale) and they are introduced along the text in the right moment. All the relevant and previous works in the area have been properly acknowledged. I only made a few notes in the pdf file, most of which are typos in the references or the occasional extra word.
