- clearly distinguish in the manuscript between measured and derived parameters

If the distinction is made in the table, it would be more unclear, so we will revise the text to clearly state that "the observed values are summarized in Table 1 and the other parameters are derived parameters.

- consider publishing the processing code to increase confidence in the dataset.
