Review of DebDab: A database of supraglacial debris thickness and physical properties

General comments:

The manuscript presents an extensive dataset of supraglacial debris properties, compiled into a database. The database is an important and valuable contribution to the research area of debris covered glaciers, as nothing on this scale has existed previously. It will be an excellent resource to which data going forward can be added to.

The results are presented clearly and to a high standard, and the article is well written.

All my previous comments have been addressed. As such, I think this article is ready to be accepted. I have added three comments below with the first enabling a clearer sentence and the second and third citation formatting point.

Line 170: 'although every property has at least 30 glaciers reporting values' is confusing – can this be reworded to 'although every property has values for at least 30 glaciers' or the meaning made clearer.

Lines 300 and 314: I think this will be fixed in the editing process, but (Scherler et al., 2018) should be Scherler et al. (2018).

Line 364: (Brock et al., 2010) to be Brock et al. (2010)
